- Encourage participants to be creative in line with the project brief
- Teach participants about mixing paints and brush techniques
- Provide finishing touches/enhancements to ensure the final artwork is of a professional standard
- Ensure the artwork/murals meet the brief
- Provide expertise in preparation; tools and materials; techniques; finishing
- Work up to 10 hours per day/50 hours per week
- Set up and pack down
- Maintain all working materials and products
- Complete the project
