Position objective

To be a key member of the Nhulunbuy Corporations Infrastructure team with primary responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the water supply and sewerage scheme for Nhulunbuy, the Industrial Estate and Gove Airport.

- Public buildings and facilities

Relationships

Internal Daily contact with the Works Coordinator, other Operations staff and Manager - Strategic Infrastructure with occasional contact with the Airport Operations and Corporate and Community Services teams as required.

External Regular contact and cooperation with contractors and members of the public

Responsibilities

- Taking responsibility for all matters relating to Water and Sewerage under Nhulunbuy Corporation control as directed by the Works Coordinator or Manager - Strategic Infrastructure.
- Responsibility for the operation and maintenance of chemical dosing equipment, including chlorine dosing equipment, used in the treatment of the Nhulunbuy Aquatic Centre and at sewerage treatment facilities
- Shared responsibility for attaining occupational health and workplace safety objectives of the Nhulunbuy Corporation
- Provide a positive, engaged, respectful and professional contribution to the Nhulunbuy Corporation at all times
- Procurement, receipt and storage of spare parts and

- Participate (with remuneration) in NCL's on call/after hour roster, delivering a 24/7/365 response to emergencies (rotation of approximately one week in six)
- Other duties as reasonably required.

Minimum requirements

Essential skills and experience

- Ability to work unsupervised and/or work well in a team environment.
- Demonstrated experience in a Municipal Services workplace.
- Ability to identify work tasks, set priorities and organise work schedules on a daily and ongoing basis including maintenance planning and delivery.
- Demonstrated awareness and understanding of workplace safety issues
- Ability to effectively manage direct reports.

Experience and qualifications

- Current registration as a Licensed Plumber and Drainer
- Minimum 5 years' experience in a similar role
- Current NT Driver's Licence (HR Class)
- Experience in operating backhoes or other plant equipment relevant to the position
- Experience or qualifications as a pool operator, water treatment or sewerage treatment plant operator
- Current Gas Licence
- Accreditation for testing of backflow prevention devices
- Accreditation for Safe Working in a Confined Space
- Dangerous Goods licence
- Maintenance of submersible sewerage pumps
- Any other experience relevant to the position
- Current First Aid certificate desirable.
