1. How do I find out if my flight has been delayed?

2. Who can I contact regarding lost luggage/property?

Misplaced your belongings? For items left on board your flight or lost luggage, reach out to AirNorth directly at 1800 627 474.

The Gove Airport Operations office is open Monday to Sunday from 6:00 am to 4:00 pm.

3. Is there internet access at Gove Airport?

Absolutely! Stay connected with our Wireless Internet access (Wi-Fi) available within the Terminal. Any device that supports Wi-Fi can hop on the service. Just keep an eye out for "NCL Guest" on your phone or laptop. Before you're good to go, a quick click to agree to the terms of use is all that's needed.

4. Do you charge for car parking at the Airport?

Not here! Parking at Gove Airport is entirely free of charge. Our parking area is a public space, and everyone parks at their own risk.

5. Where do I pick up passengers from at Gove Airport?

We've got your passenger pick-up game sorted! The Passenger Arrivals area is conveniently located on the right side of the terminal. Plus, for a quick and easy pick-up, we've got a 2-minute Passenger Pickup zone right in front of the terminal.

Let's all play nice and respect that 2-minute limit so that everyone can access the area smoothly.
