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Shipping Container Permit Application

Shipping container permit conditions:

The following conditions of this permit must be observed;

- The location proposed for the shipping container is acceptable.
- **ONLY ONE SHIPPING CONTAINER ON THE RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY AT ANY TIME.**
- Care to be taken to the verge and street kerbing.
- The doors of the shipping container are to be fitted with a device for holding them in an open position for safety in the event of strong winds during periods when the doors may be open and so persons are not trapped inside due to the doors slamming shut.
- Once the works have been completed, NCL is to be notified so an inspection can be conducted to ensure that the kerbing, drainage pit, nature strip or any other assets have not been damaged.
- The location proposed in the application for the shipping container may be suitable, however, when the container is not being loaded and/or unloaded make sure that the container is locked to prevent unauthorized access.
- Stabilize the shipping container as required if the site location is a slope.
- No shipping container is to be placed on the road.
- Approval for residential properties is granted for a period of up to fourteen (14) days.
- Approval for industrial/commercial properties is granted for a period of up to thirty (30) days.
- If requested by NC, the sub-lease holders and/or occupants must submit a Cyclone Management plan which clearly defines the actions to be taken to secure any shipping container/s in the event of cyclone or severe weather conditions. This will be required for all shipping container permits between 1 December and 30 April in any given year.
