RE: Terms of Use for the Gove Peninsula Waste Management Facility

Nhulunbuy Corporation Limited (NC) would like to remind all account holders and users of the Gove Peninsula Waste Management Facility (Facility) the terms and conditions of entry and use.

Separation of Materials Disposed

Waste disposed of at the Facility must be separated into the following categories:

- Concrete / Masonry products
- Clean Steel
- Biodegradables / compact matter and other products that can go straight to Landfill.
- Asbestos / contaminated waste
- Tyres
- Batteries
- Chemicals, oils, paints
- Green waste
- Whitegoods (de-gassed)
- Vehicles (subject to a separate application form and declaration of liquids removal)

Fees and Charges Attributable to Vehicles Used

Fees and Charges for the Facility are listed on NC's website. Fees for the facility are distinguished by the type of vehicle used to dispose of waste. Please be advised, regardless of whether the vehicle is partially or completely full, the entire rate for the vehicle type will be charged. It is in the best interest of the user to completely fill the vehicle before depositing the waste at the Facility.

Surveillance

Please be reminded that NC (and contractors engaged by NC) operate surveillance equipment within the Facility. By entering the Facility, you consent to information about yourself (including images)

being recorded by such surveillance equipment and to the NC disclosing the information recorded to anyone to the extent that NC deems such disclosure to be necessary so as to protect NC's lawful interests, the public interest or the safety of persons or property present at the Facility.
